Positions and their responsibilities:

Your general responsibilities as an *editor*:

- ★ Attend monthly board-member meetings.
- ★ Review writing submissions to the website. This means determining appropriate content warnings, making copy edits (only editing unintentional spelling/grammatical errors), etc.
- ★ Work with other editors to help decide the highlighted work of the month.

Your general responsibilities as a *publicity manager*:

- ★ Manage the instagram account, including making official posts and choosing what we can do to promote the organization (whimsical reels).
- ★ Reach out to local schools/organizations for opportunities to promote BAYWB through in-person presentations, transference of our information, etc.

Your general responsibilities as a *visual designer*:

- ★ Format and upload submissions on our website after they're cleared by our editors.
- ★ Help with general visuals within the website.
- ★ Help design our bimonthly editions.

The application process:

- 1) Fill out the following form and submit a PDF via email to bayoungwriters@gmail.com. Please only fill out the section(s) you want to apply for, and leave the rest blank. Experience is encouraged, but not required!
- 2) The current board will review your application.
- 3) If we think you'd be a good fit as a member, we'll schedule a quick zoom interview to get to know you better.
- 4) Following the interview, we'll invite you to participate in board meetings and perform your desired position for one to two weeks (basically a mock-trial!).
- 5) After the trial run, we'll review whether or not we think you'll be a good fit for the board in a private meeting.
